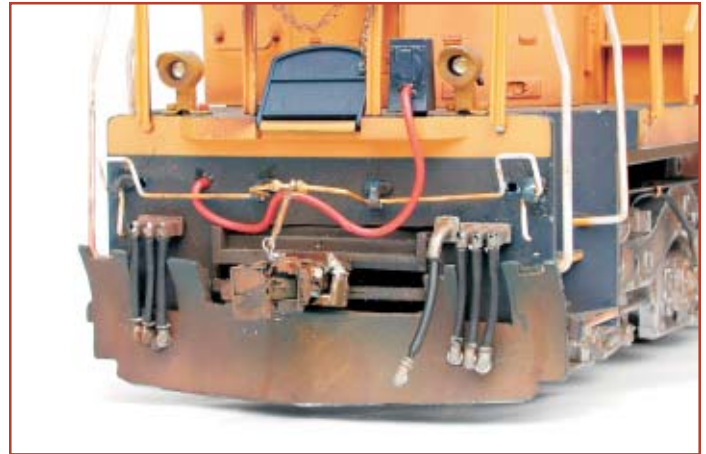


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ON THE COVER

THE 4-6-4 WHEEL arrangement came about in the mid 1920s when the New York Central needed to upgrade its crack passenger locomotive fleet.
